THE CLIENT

The Asian Football Cup was a multi venue sporting event held in Australia in 2015 where 16 teams played matches in stadiums across the country over the course of 4 weeks.

Digital media is one of FIFA's key strategies in the growth of the game, particularly in emerging soccer nations such as Japan and China, who have the potential to contribute immense commercial value, therefore enabling the attending media to upload online match reports during the game was a critical factor in the success of the tournament overall.

THE PROJECT

GQI's project was to ensure the delivery of 'tournament ready' network connectivity to each host venue by either enhancing the existing infrastructure or deploying new technology solutions. This not only included ensuring that the attending media had sufficient connectivity but also critical match day operations including Ticketing, Retail Point of Sale and Security.

The success criteria for this project was measured by the following:

- Performance of the network to the governing body's standards.
- Strict budget considerations the project finance was driven by sponsors looking for solid ROI.
- Working to a fixed tournament schedule delivering within schedule was critical.
